



## ACTIVITY 12: Reimagining Seeds

**Age:** 6 years and above.

**Materials:** A4 sheet, pencil, different types of seeds, sketch of seeds

### Steps:

1. Go for a walk near your home and find different kinds of seeds fallen on the ground. You can also look in your kitchen for some seeds.
2. Observe the seeds closely and notice details in each seed. What are the different shapes, sizes and colours you notice? Do the seeds remind you of something else?
3. Spend some time reimagining the seed if it were bigger or smaller. What if it were a part of some other object?
4. Choose a seed and make a sketch by closely observing the seed. Add to the basic sketch of the seed by adding new details to transform it to a new reimagined object.
5. Once you finish, share/note down what was interesting and what different seeds reminded you of.
