



ACTIVITY 2: CREATING VEHICLE

Age: Children to adults can try out this activity.

Materials: Pots, pans, utensils, bottles, bottle caps, cardboard box, bags, old books, newspapers, dough, recyclables, aluminium foil, etc.

Steps:

1. Look around your home and find at least 5 materials with which you can create your favorite vehicle in 3D.
2. Think of all the vehicles you have seen, they could be two-wheeler, three-wheeler, four-wheeler or more. You can browse the photos and notice different details on each one.
3. What kind of shapes can you see? Are all of them the same size? What makes them stand out from the rest?
4. Choose one vehicle and create the vehicle using home found materials. Start with the bigger shapes and then add the finer details. You can make the vehicle stand on the floor by stacking your objects or lean it against the wall to support it.
5. Share your artwork with your family and friends. Share with them why you chose the vehicle and what you found interesting while doing the activity.
