



### ACTIVITY 3: INVESTIGATING PAPERS

**Age:** For all ages.

**Materials:** A4 paper or scrap paper, fevicol, newspapers, cardboard box, magazines, old books, etc.

#### Steps:

1. Look around your home and find at least 3 different kinds of papers including one blank sheet and a fevicol. Choose different colours of papers to make it look vibrant.
2. Think of all the geometric and free form shapes you know and tear the papers into different shapes and sizes from big to small. Remember you are not creating anything specific and just exploring the properties of the papers.
3. Get your A4 sheet or blank sheet and glue down the papers you have torn by letting them touch each other, place one shape on top of the other, overlap each other, create a pattern, textures, etc.
4. Also try adding details on top of your papers by adding smaller shapes and sizes.
5. Share your artwork with your family and friends. Share with them the discovery you have made and what you found interesting while doing the activity.
