



ACTIVITY 7: IMAGINARY FLOWER COLLAGE

Age: For all ages.

Materials: Scissor, fevicol, newspapers, magazines, old books, etc.

Steps:

1. Look around your home and find at least 5 different kinds of papers with different colors.
2. Think about the shape of different parts of your flower/plant. Cut/tear the papers while referring to your sketch from the previous activity.
3. Glue all the shapes together to create your imaginary flower collage by starting from the biggest shapes.
4. Now try adding details like the pattern and textures by cutting smaller shapes and placing them on top of the bigger shapes.
5. Share with your family and friends the difference between sketching and creating a collage of your imaginary flower.
