



ACTIVITY 9: INSECT PAINTING WITH NATURAL COLOURS

Age: For all ages.

Materials: A4 Sheet, paint brush, homemade brush, leaves, grass, flowers, soil, seeds, spices, vegetables, etc.

Steps:

1. Think about some of the insects you like. What if you were to paint a big version of them? What would that be? What are the shapes and patterns on it?
2. Look back on your colour exploration from the previous activity. Create only the colours you would want to use or mix to create another shade.
3. Take an A4 sheet with a paint brush. Draw an outline painting of your favourite insect with your preferred colour.
4. After the outline is done, paint the rest of the insect using different natural colours you created. You could mix them as well to see how the colours change.
5. Share your painting with your family and friends by telling them what you found interesting while doing the activity.
