





ACTIVITY 6: PORTRAIT OF FAVOURITE PERSON WITH FOUND MATERIALS

Age: 6yrs and above

Materials:

Rocks, leaves, mud, ropes, threads, flowers, sand, seeds, waste vegetables, etc.

Step 1: Look around your house and find any material with which you can create the face of your favorite person. They could be your friend or family members.

Points to keep in mind:

- 1. If possible, find a partner who can work with you, a sibling or a family member.
- 2. Ask them to do the same activity, but individually.
- 3. Look around your house and see if there are materials you can find which can be used to make the face of your favorite person by arranging the materials on a flat surface like a table or the floor.
- 4. Find at least 5 different materials which you could use. If possible, avoid using the same materials you used to create your face.
- 5. Take a close look of the face of your favorite person and observe all parts of their face.

- 6. Start with the biggest part of their face, arrange materials to create the shape of their face using any of the material you have picked.
- 7. Then move on to the smaller details like their nose, lips, eyes, ears, etc. and arrange more materials to make the face look like your favorite person.
- 8. Remember to take photos as you create their face with found materials.

Points to consider with your partner

- 1. After you both are done, show to each other what you have created.
- 2. If there are any missing details you would like them to add, share with each other in a positive manner and complete the portrait of your favorite person with the help of the feedback received.
