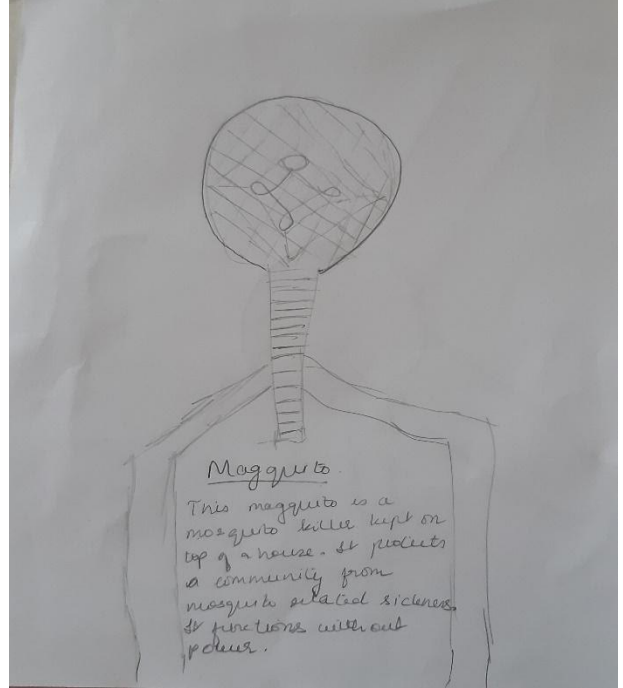




ಬುಟ್ಟುಮನೆ ಪ್ರಯೋಗ

ACTIVITY 8: DRAWING OF COMBINED HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Age: 6yrs and above

Materials: Household materials like chairs, tables, bed, shelves, almirah, fan, vessels, wood, metals, carpets, broom, etc.

Step 1: Look around your house and find any home materials you would like to combine and create a new object with special powers.

Points to keep in mind:

1. If possible, find a partner who can work with you, a sibling or a family member.
2. Ask them to do the same activity, but individually.
3. Look around your house and see if there are simple objects you would like to combine to make something new.
4. Think about what kind of special power you would like to give to this new object? Would it have power to help you, your family, or even the community?

5. Try combining different types of materials and observe what it might look like and what power it can have. Once you have decided on which materials you would like to combine, observe the objects for its shapes and detail, and then sketch your combined object.
6. After drawing it, give it a name and describe its special power.

Points to consider with your partner

1. After you both are done, show to each other what you have created.
2. If there are any details you would like them to add, share with each other in a positive manner and complete your drawing and story with the help of the feedback received.
