“Initially I thought COVID-19 had halted my child’s education. There was no form of learning happening and he would spend all his time playing. But ArtSparks Foundation started sending activities and an Art kit for him to start working on. It was difficult for a textbook to keep him focused. But now I see him doing activities independently, without having to be reminded. He even gets all of his doubts cleared by asking the Facilitators who gladly help him.

One day he sketched a ‘Helper Robot’ as one of his activities. He explained its functions to me saying that “the robot would work in the fields with you so that no animals harm our crops, and you don’t work alone.” His thinking brought tears of joy.

My child has gained confidence to do his work independently and most importantly, has started believing in himself. For this, I’m deeply thankful to the ArtSparks Facilitators and all their hard work and efforts.”
