



### ACTIVITY 1: CREATING ANIMAL WITH HOME FOUND MATERIALS

**Age:** Children, young adults to adults can try out this activity.

**Materials:** Rocks, pebbles, leaves, mud, ropes, threads, flowers, sand, seeds, pulses, fruit peels, waste vegetables, etc.

#### Steps:

1. Think about the different kinds of animals you know; something you have seen in textbook, TV, etc. or even have at home like pet animals.
2. Observe the animals closely by holding them if you have one at home or by looking at the photos and notice different details on each one.
3. What kind of shapes can you see? Are all of them the same size? What are the marks, textures and patterns on the animals?
4. Next, choose one animal and create the animal using home found materials. Start with the bigger shapes or outline and then add the finer details.
5. Share your artwork with your family and friends. Share with them why you chose which animal and what you found interesting while doing the activity.
