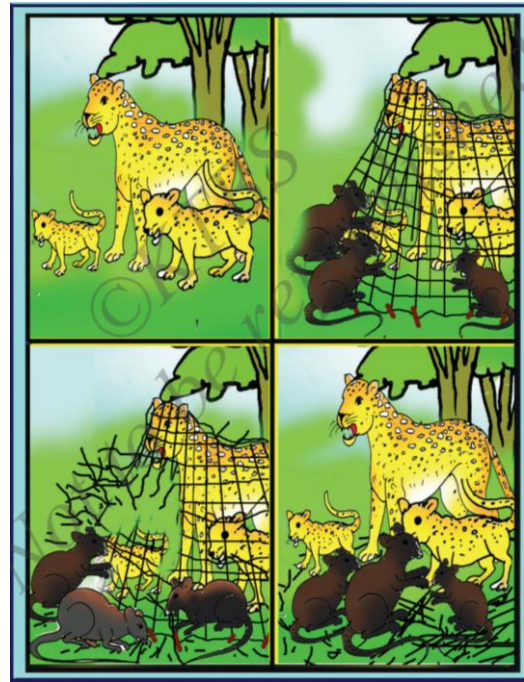
Subject – Language - Kannada

Art Medium – Picture Story

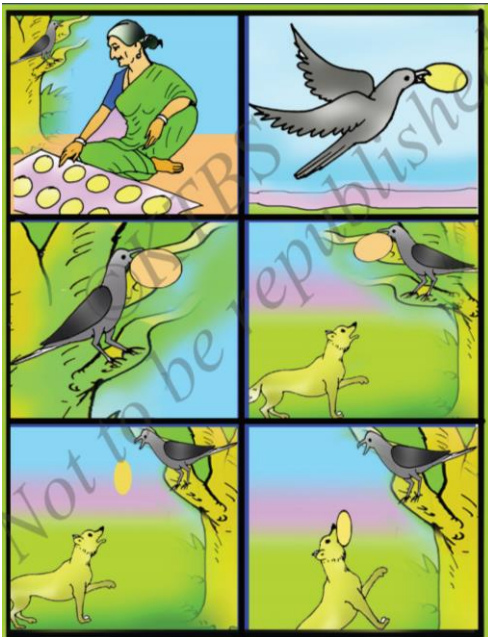

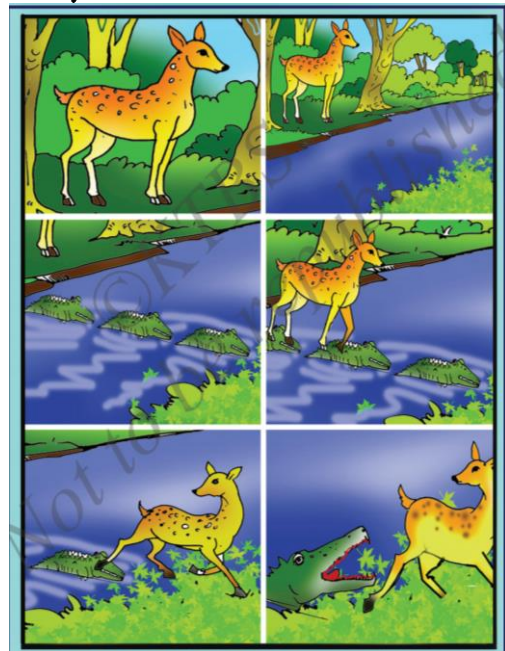

### Session Plan –

#### Session 1 – Picture Story

##### Academic Goals for this session –

- Students will begin to identify pictures from their textbook.
- Students will begin to create a story for the picture.

##### Art Goals for this session –

- Students will develop their communication skills by looking at the pictures and narrating their stories.
- Students will also develop imagination while creating their own story.



### **Materials**

- Nali Kali Textbook (Karnataka State Syllabus Textbook)

### **Activity –**

#### **Introduction**

**Time – 5 minutes**

- Start a conversation with students about stories. Ask them if they have heard or seen any story.
- Discuss - Who is there in a story? Where does it take place? What happens in the story?

#### **Demonstration**

**Time – 20 minutes**

- Show the first picture story from the book, ask students to silently observe the image for 2 minutes.
- Point towards the first box and ask students to tell what they see. After that ask them to think of what could be happening in that picture.
- Repeat the same for the remaining boxes for that story.
- Based on the responses demonstrate creating a story with the pictures given.
- Similarly repeat the same for another picture story.
- Let students know that now they will work in pairs to create a story for a picture.

#### **Working Period**

**Time – 15 minutes**

- Divide the students into pairs.
- Remind them to observe the image for two minutes silently.
- After they have observed they can collectively look at each picture box and create their own story.

#### **Reflection**

**Time – 15 minutes**

- Let students know that they can share their stories with the larger group together.
- Teacher could record these stories or document them.
