



Benefits of Learner-Centered

There are multiple research studies stating the benefits of applying learner-centered approach in our classrooms.

Few of them include –

1. **Increases Inner Motivation Towards Learning** – Since a learner-centered classroom environment focuses on every learner and validates their point of view it builds students confidence. Students therefore build a sense of belonging in the classroom, become more motivated, and contribute more.
2. **Promotes Thinking Skills** – With the use of dialogues in the classroom, students become more flexible in their thinking as they learn to accept multiple perspectives. Students learn to analyse their prior knowledge, compare different opinions, and evaluate various perspectives before making decisions. Since the dialogue is rooted in students own lived experiences, they are better able to connect their learning to these experiences, and therefore understand content better.
3. **Builds Life Skills** – For example, communication skills, social skills, collaboration etc., - In such classrooms students are constantly engaging and dialoguing with fellow students they learn how to communicate their ideas with others. In the process of receiving information, they learn to listen, evaluate, and contribute in an acceptable manner.
4. **Help Transfer Skills to the Real World** – There are multiple life skills that students develop through the learner-centered approach. This enables them to adapt to constantly changing real-world environments. This ensures that we are building a future with individual citizens who are capable of facing challenges, engaging in difficult dialogues and making effective decisions, and contributing actively to society.
